

a note from the pastor

Dear Church at the Mall Family and Welcomed Guests:

We are experiencing the blessing of God on our great church. I love the season of Lent we are in as we intentionally prepare our hearts for Easter. Parents and grandparents, please pick up a copy of Pastopher's fantastic Lent Calendar for families. It is filled with meaningful activities that will help you and your children experience God.

Today we have our Lent Devotional books available that will help guide you through this 40- day season of seeking God. We have a limited number available today at the Information Desk (one per family please). They can also be downloaded at churchatthemall.com/easter. As we think about the time between now and Easter, I encourage you to use this time to seek God in a way you have never sought Him before. Seek His will and His purpose for you. Intentionally think about the sufferings, beatings, forsakenness, and crucifixion of Jesus Christ. Choose a specific time to fast. Fasting can change your life. Also, I encourage you to take the Lent Prayer and personalize it. Read the Books of Mark and Luke during this Lent season.

Offerings on Sunday, March 29 and Sunday, April 5

Before the message today, I will share specifics of the offerings on Palm Sunday, March 29, and Easter Sunday, April 5. Last week I spoke of a sacrificial gift offering on March 29 for Debt Elimination and on April 5 for 6 Missional Related Causes and for the Annie Armstrong offering. (The Annie Armstrong offering is for North American Missions through the Southern Baptist Convention.) Today's announcement will go further in sharing HOW we are going to accomplish what we will do. As you will hear, we are demonstrating a huge level of faith that God will provide. You will also hear the specific ministries we will be giving to in our Sunday, April 5 offering. God never allows our church to become complacent. He has given us much and He expects much from us. These offerings will show that we believe Goal One of our Vision 2020 Goals for the next five years. Goal One has two components of equal importance: #1. eliminating our \$4.1 million in old debt and #2. raising \$1 Million each year for missional-related causes. I believe that these two offerings will be game-changers for our church. EVERYONE can make a sacrificial, financial gift. We cannot all give the same amount, but we can each sacrifice in order to GLORIFY GOD and MAKE DISCIPLES.
