We need to love, affirm, enjoy, and be thankful for the time God gave us with Ben. No one can replace Ben, but God has someone He will send for this next season of blessing."

I want to assure the parents of our students that we are working hard to make sure we don't miss a beat in student worship. We are thankful that Sumner Curtis has stepped in until March as an interim worship leader or until we find the next worship pastor. He is a worship leader at Southeastern University with a phenomenal voice, ability, and spirit.
